- HB 73 Mandatory 10% budget cut in all State Departments

- HB 147 Creates an act prohibiting the use of full Social Security numbers on State forms

- HB 148 Amends The Liquor Code providing for sales by certain liquor licensees, deals with catering provisions as well as happy hour provisions

- HB 149 Provides for issuance of "In God We Trust Plate"  
**Referred to Transportation 1/21/2011**



- HB 161 Amends Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) further providing for registration of sexual offenders – deals with invasion of privacy charges.  
**Referred to Judiciary 1/21/2011**
- HB 793 Amends Title 75 to include the Distinguished Service Cross, Distinguished Flying Cross, Navy Cross, Air Force Cross and Silver Star to available license plates.  
**Referred to Transportation 2/23/2011**
- HB 1233 Amends Titles 18 & 42 to increase minimum jail time to 50 years in prison and maximum of life imprisonment with no possibility of parole for first conviction and mandatory life sentence with no possibility of parole for second conviction; and provides for increased mandatory minimum sentencing for sex offenders and predators (Prior HB 164)  
**Referred to House Judiciary 3/29/2011**
- HB 1234 Amends Title 18 providing for arson endangering person or occupied/unoccupied property (guilty if person recklessly endangers another person, but not limited to, an emergency responder; as well as regardless if property is occupied or unoccupied)  
**Referred to Judiciary 3/29/2011**
- HB 1235 Amends Engineer, Land Surveyor and Geologist Registration Law to add provisions for the profession of forestry.  
**Referred to Professional Licensure 3/29/2011**
- HB 1387 Amends Act of 6/9/1936 Sp. Sess 1, P.L.13, No.4 which would provide for the emergency tax on liquor (Johnstown Flood Tax) to decrease the 18% added to every purchase at a state store; rate would be lowered to 9% as of 1/1/2011 and 1/1/12 tax rate would be 0%

- HB 1388 Amends Title 75 regarding DUI penalties  
**Referred to Transportation 4/26/2011**
- HB 1389 Amends Titles 18 (Crimes and Offenses) and Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) to provide additional offenses and penalties relating to assault and assault of a first responder in the performance of their duty.

HB 1390

Amends Landlord-Tenant Act (Act #20 of 1951) that would change from 10 to 7 the number of days a district judge has to schedule a landlord-tenant hearing and change from 10 to 5 days the time frame a tenant has to appeal the judgment rendered
